Hands-on Curriculum

Application Process and Timeline

Apply to Nebraska

Visit Common App or admissions.unl.edu to apply beginning August 1.

Apply to the Raikes School Through the Honors Application in MyRED 2

Complete the application by November 15. Late applications are only accepted if space is available.

Prepare for Interview

Interviews take place in January and February and are a half-day, on-campus experience for selected candidates.

Raikes School Selection

Selected students receive offers in February along with notifications of a Raikes School scholarship award.
