· Canvas page seems very scattered. Majority of the powerpoint slides are photos that do not provide a lot of help when returning to them to study. Rely heavily on textbook for exam.

• It is very difficult to learn the content because of the way he teaches. If he focused more on the content and less on abstract examples, that would be helpful. It seems like he is trying to put on a show about marketing every lecture instead of teach marketing.

• The exams for this class are extremely difficult and are sometimes hard to understand. Doing only the notes and exercises in class is not enough but I don't think that is portrayed a ton.

• I often struggled with studying for exams in this class. I wasn't always sure what to go over and would have liked if the TA review slides were posted on the canvas site.

• I don't feel like we cover enough of what is on our exams in class.

• Throughout this course, I felt like the lectures weren't related to the content on the exam. Most of the time, I could simply look at the review slides and get a good grade, even if I never went to a lecture.

• The assignments that were given weren't always the best way to learn the material or study for the exams. There was a lot of emphasis put on exams but not very many opportunities given for assignments to help prepare for exams.

• The exams are extremely hard due to very poor application. The study material is understandable but not like the exam. The class is very difficult to get above a B in

• To me, in this class it felt like we were reading about one thing, being lectured on another thing, and tested on other things. I felt a lack of consistency in what we were learning and it was hard to understand the content because of this. I liked the student engagement and involvement during the lectures, but the activities did not promote my learning and didn't help me understand the course content any better. Also, there was a lot of material covered on each exam and it was hard to make sure you knew everything for the exams, which I think ties back to the lack of consistency I felt with the learning materials. The canvas page felt disorganized to me and it was difficult to find specific lectures. I think greater consistency and organization would have promoted my learning in an effective manner.

• I found that I had a hard time trying to figure out what I need to study for the exams. Some of the content we learned in class did not apply to the exams.

• The PowerPoints were helpful, but our small, weekly quizzes were not.

• I read every chapter and went to every class and reviewed before each test and my highest score on the test was an 82. I also feel as though there should be more weight on projects vs. tests

• There was not enough to help my grade at all. I don't understand how it is possible to do so well and still have such a poor grade. I just don't think the grading scale is correct or fair at all. The exams were meant to trick you--there were words that I literally did not know the meaning to. They were worded so poorly and so I just couldn't do well even if I was super prepared. The canvas was also so confusing for this class and not set up well at all.

· Sometimes it took awhile for grades or feedback to come after a case study.

• This course has plenty of room for improvement. For starters, the tests are completely ridiculous. Every exam was not a test of our marketing knowledge, but rather how well can you read questions that are meant to trick you. There is no consistency in the structure of every exam except for them being multiple choice, the way questions are worded are seemingly set up for you to fail, and if you want to go over your exam with the Professor, that is actually a TAs job. Second, class is a complete waste of time. At the beginning of the semester, I left every hour and fifteen minute session wishing for my time back. The powerpoints shown in class is a lazy form of teaching material and the lecture has no correlation to what you will later be tested on. Third, Professor Mackalski is an inaccessible professor that has no care for his students success and would rather promote his work (former students companies and personal case studies) than actually aid in the learning of marketing. The ONLY thing I learned all semester was the phrase, "think like a marketer" which has proven to be a very VERY expensive waste of time, money, and energy.
