• The activities that are done in class as well as the slides provided are the most basic and general notes possible. The tests are extremely difficult and account for almost the entire grade. Class time is used for very basic activities that do not effectively prepare students for the tests.

• I never felt prepared for any of the tests. I attended all the lectures but one, and read the book and took notes. Every exam felt like one massive trick question. This is really frustrating because no matter how many hours of work I put into preparing for the tests, I walked out with at best a mediocre score. There is no reason I should have a 95 in Chemistry and a much worse grade in this class..

• Each exam was incredibly difficult and did not make sense from and exam standpoint. Questions are very opinionated and required much thought as to what the professor deemed the "right" answer.

· often the slides were hard to follow and did not directly apply to material that we were tested on

• The course lectures and slides do not help prepare for the test and are not taught well in class.

• The tests are absolutely nothing like what we learn in class. Every question is unclear and does not represent what we learn in class.

• If I could select more than just course learning materials and tools I would but I can't. The slide deck that Robert Mackalski provides to the class and presents everyday has nothing to do with over half of the exams. The in class experiments and work he does on the while boards provide absolutely no help to anyone when trying to prepare for the exams. His slide deck seems as if it's not his own or he does not hnow what is on the exams given that the material we do get out of class does not align well in any matter with the content on the exams.

• I don't think this course prepared me very well for the tests. Something I think that would help is a study guide with all the objectives. The review sessions were semi-useful but didn't provide a lot of information. I think the reviews could have been a little longer and had more practice questions with a wider range of questions similar to the test.

• Tests are very difficult and questions seem like that are trying to trick the individual writing the exam. I wish we had more opportunity for points rather than most of our grade coming from the tests.

• In class lectures seemed to not correlate the best with the test but the textbook was very

• The slides didn't cover even half of the things you need to know for the tests, and most students found the tests were extremely hard compared to what we learned in class, so it would've helped more if the material on the tests and the types of questions were more clear so the students could be better prepared on how to study

• The issue with this class is the significant disconnect between the lecture and the tests. Many questions were pulled out of the book, and very little of the lecture was utilized for the midterms, encompassing most of the grade; furthermore, the lack of responsibility and initiative that the LAs provided to the course actively hurt the space the lectures and the professor created. The review lectures were, bare minimum, and at times detrimental to the learning for the upcoming midterm. In multiple instances, the information for the review was incorrect or created false generalizations of the content. I attended all four review sessions and believed the course and its learning objectives would be better without them.

The tests are also a pain because we are expected to know content from the book that is not covered at all or even indirectly during lectures which makes some questions very much out of no where.

• Having the exam open for one week was great, but only having the LA's review on the Tuesday was hard, because Tuesday's were also the only day we had off from your class. So it would leave it to us of, do we miss the LA's review to go take the exam or do we miss class on Thursday and go take the exam. Do I miss the review or not? I understand other students who are not in a lot of credit hours don't have to worry about that, but for some, the only time available was the time off from class on Tuesday, but then they would miss the review session. I understand with about 400+ students not everyone will get their way, and I don't know a solution for this either, just something to think about. Maybe also cancel classes on Thursdays so student could take the exam during that time or offer another review session!

• The test questions were too complex for the content and area of study. I did better on my accounting tests than these and studied a ton for them. The questions seem to be written to make you second guess or get tripped up. Re-evaluate whether you can take the tests with ease and see what makes you second guess. When you take the tests or see the results are the problems people are getting wrong really a content issue.

• There is so much that could use improvement. One, when asking you for clarification on anything you make it even more confusing. The first group case study was confusing and when people asked questions you steered them in the wrong direction and said make up numbers which made no sense. Two, when the exams close I really wish you would just open them up for us to see them like every other professor. Having to go to office hours or see a TA/LA is annoying and unnecessary. Especially when sometimes you were not even in your office. Three, I wish you would post the whole PowerPoint instead of the PowerPoint with pieces missing, it is frustrating. Four, the exams are made to trick us and for an intro class it seems unfair. The scores would be low and you would' curve them even a couple points. When not one student gets a perfect score and the average is as low as some of our exam scores were most professors curve it. Five, the feedback on the case studies was not helpful and sometimes disagreeable. Overall, this class was very unenjoyable for me and I did not appreciate the lack of respect you have for your students.

• i think the professor needs to make his lectures align with the tests more. a lot of times, things we go over in class do not relate at all to tests. while his lectures can be interesting, they just dont align with what we're tested over, which is why i think so many students stopped showing up towards the end of the semester.

I think this could be improved to help people understand how they are being evaluated and how to do certain homework tasks.
